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


After two years of record generosity, giving overall is down in 2022.

Total 2022 U.S. giving reached

2021 Giving Total \$516.65 billion







Economic conditions in 2022



Disposable **personal income declined** 0.1%. (-7.5% adjusted for inflation)



S&P 500 declined 19.4% (-25.4% adjusted for inflation). Total giving as a percentage of **GDP was down to 2.0%** from 2.3% in 2020, a 40-year high.



Inflation reached 8%, the highest in 40 years.

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




83.5% of all giving comes from individuals

- Bill Gates pledged \$5.11 billion to the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.
- MacKenzie Scott pledged \$3.82 billion to various organizations.
- Warren Buffett gave \$758 million to the Susan Thompson Buffett Foundation, Sherwood Foundation, Howard G. Buffett Foundation and NoVo Foundation.
- John and Laura Arnold gave \$617 million to the Laura and John Arnold Foundation.


Mega-gifts represent 5% of total giving.


