



Total 2023 U.S. Giving Reached

2022 Giving Total (Adjusted) \$546.61 billion

\$557.16 billion





Economic Conditions in 2023 (adjusted for inflation)



Disposable personal income increased by 3.8%



S&P 500 increased 19.3% between 2022-2023 Total giving as a percentage of **GDP grew 2.1%**



Inflation reached 4.1%, dropping from 2022's 8% average rate of inflation (which was *the highest in 40 years*)


